Alfred Joseph MORNEAU, born on 31 May 1915 at Salem, MA , son of Pascal Joseph MORNEAU and Marguerite PELLETIER. He began military service on 19 Jun 1942 at Camp Lee, VA, as a PFC in the U.S. Army. From there, he was sent to Fort Bragg, NC, as part of the 94th Quarter Master, Baking Battalion. He ended military service on 30 Apr 1943. He then worked at the Dog Cart, also known as the Hole in the Wall, at 12 Washington St., Salem MA. He owned it for one year and he sold the best steamed hot dogs on the North Shore for 5 cents. The price later went up to 2 for 15 cents. He was a postal worker between 1944 and 1975 at Salem, MA. He died on 24 Sep 2000 at Beverly, MA, and was buried on 27 Sep 2000 at Greenlawn Cemetery, Salem, MA.
